Please ensure everything is named

Suitcase must weigh <u>no more</u> than 18 kgs (All bags will be weighed on check-in) Students must be able to lift and carry all of their own luggage.

# <u>Suitcase</u>

Underwear and socks

- 6 Pairs of pants. 2-3 pairs of <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> pants/mid length shorts, 1-2 pairs of jeans and 1-2 pairs of smart track pants/long pants or long skirts
- 1 Smart Casual outfit for the musical and orchestral concert (the same outfit)
- 7 Shirts. Must have sleeves. No spaghetti straps, backless or strapless shirts permitted. A few long or <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> sleeved shirts as well as short sleeved shirts please
- 1 Black performance uniform and gold ribbon
- 1 Black ballet flats (suitable for walking long distances in)
- 3 Pairs of knee high black stockings
- 1 Pair of enclosed sneakers/walking shoes
- 2 Jumpers/jackets
- 1 Pair of pyjamas
- 1 Long sleeved Black jacket or zip up jumper to go on top of the performance uniform
- 1 Tour Hat
- 1 Small travel towel
- 1 Rain poncho (NB: No Umbrellas)
- 1 Laundry Bag

## <u>Toiletries</u>

- Sanitary items
- Small travel size shampoo and conditioner
- Soap/travel size body wash,
- Sanitizer wipes/gel, razor, sunscreen
- Hairbrush, toothbrush, toothpaste (small size)
- Please share GHD's. <u>No hairdryers</u>. All rooms will be equipped

## Other Items

- Music Folder- Green Clayfield College folder for instrumentalists. Black Display folder with all music for Canzona. (including 2 pencils and an eraser). Please ensure that all folders are in excellent condition.
- American adaptor. Please share these if possible
- Mobile Phones/Camera at own risk. NO LAPTOPS, NO IPADS OR TABLETS
- Small amount of laundry powder in a sealed container
- Travel peg less clothes line (optional)

# All performance uniform and music requirements will need to be placed in a named bag that the students can pack separately from their back pack when required for day trips

Black performance uniform, knee high black stockings, black ballet flats, gold ribbon (new type only), green music folder for instrumentalists/black music folder for Canzona, music, stand, pencil case with two pencils and an eraser.

### What to pack in your carry on backpack

Please note students are to have a named back pack (back packs are being kindly donated and will be given out to students at the Tour Concert in September. Please purchase a Clayfield College Bag Tag from the College Shop to attach to the backpack. Students are encouraged to have their small wallet concealed under their clothes in a travel pouch when on tour.

- Pen to fill in Customs forms on the plane.
- Passport
- Mobile Phone at own risk and mobile phone policy must have been signed and returned
- Camera
- Tour booklet
- sanitary products
- Your violin/viola/clarinet/flute/oboe/trumpet/alto saxophone (as carry on luggage)
- Water bottle empty please to go through customs
- Sanitizing wipes/gel, small pack of tissues
- Tour cap
- Travel Neck pillow (optional)
- No animal/plant snacks please
- No nail files, no sharp objects
- Liquid, aerosol or gel products must be in containers of 100 millilitres/grams or less.
- The containers must be carried in one transparent, resealable plastic bag, like the one in the image below.
- The four sides of the bag's sealed area must add up to no more than 80 centimetres (e.g. 20x20 cm or 15x25 cm).
- The plastic bag must be the type that can be sealed and resealed with a sealing mechanism, like a sandwich bag or freezer bag. Only one bag is allowed for each passenger. All containers must fit comfortably into the plastic bag and the bag must be sealed.
- Medication must be in your backpack and have an accompanying doctor's letter and suitably labelled with name.



#### What to wear to the Airport

- Long pants/ smart tracksuit pants
- Shirt
- Jacket/Jumper
- Closed in shoes- sneakers. No ugg boots allowed.
- Socks
- Travel money pouch (to be worn)
- Camera- for tour group photo

- String players: complete spare set of strings and rosin
- Woodwind players: a box of spare reeds, cork grease

# **Clayfield College Dress Code for Excursions, Camps and Free Dress Days**

Dress standards must be sun smart and conservative. Tops/shirts must be of a suitable length to have no midriff showing and must have sleeves.
